Major Goals:

- Provide a domain for networking
- A potential section for featured articles in the university newsletter/newspaper
- A plug & play student club with all necessary resources available.
 - Guidelines for how to hold meetings and invite guest speakers.
 - Assistance with the initial creation of social media pages and research projects.

Application Requirements:

- President must be in a Geoscience/Planetary Science/Biology/Chemistry/Physics/Astronomy program.
- At least 1 full time faculty member who agrees to serve as a faculty advisor.
- Endorsement of your application by the designated faculty advisor.
- An organized group of students with at least 3 undergraduate/graduate students in a related program.
- Detailed description of initial goal, i.e. increase membership by 25%

What The Chapter Will Do:

- Collect student member dues (\$/year) & track financial summary
- Create and post social media content in collaboration with ASA National.
- Construct research projects with the members in which the student chapter can produce secondary or primary research for potential publication in an academic journal.

- Submit at least 1 research review/project conducted by the chapter per semester for publication in the ASA National Journal/Blog.
- Hold events, forums, and field trips.
- Hold meetings and document meeting statistics
 - Number of professional meetings with an invited speaker
 - Participation count
 - Number of meetings with student presentations and/or paper(s) presented
 - Highlight a few of the best meetings each year, explain why the meeting was popular, describe the invited speaker and why they were chosen.
 - Number of field trips
 - Number of social functions
 - Number of executive/planning meetings
